"LIVING IN THE KINGDOM"
Parish Mission
April 27, 2008 - April 30, 2008

The long awaited parish mission has ended! The Spiritual Life Committee along with Father Mike invited Mr. John Schweisthal, a layman of Good News Ministries, to conduct the four evening sessions. There was an opportunity each evening to complete an evaluation. We also felt that it would be "life giving" to ask some attendees for their reactions and what they might have gained spiritually from the Mission. Everyone asked responded in a positive way to the request.

John gave us a lot of food for thought and action. The point that struck me was the "hidden treasure" passage. When John pointed to the cross and stated that Jesus gave it all for us... I again realized the sacrifice... (Life long member)

The Mission was like a very large Christian vitamin pill for me. The hugs and words shared and realizing God's unconditional love ... this is what I am trying to realize from the Mission. (Veteran member)

The four evenings were well spent. Now we are trying to live what John taught! Stop worrying and let God do it! (Happy young seniors)

I am one of the people who worry about everything! John told us that Jesus tells us "not to worry". I don't usually "seek the Kingdom" first in my life. I worry about my house chores and then I want to spend time with my children and see God in them. That is "living in the Kingdom". I need to put people first before my desire to worry about my chores. Then I guess I just need to go to sleep! (Busy younger mother)

We thought the Mission was fantastic, enlightening and enjoyable. Loved every session and would have liked more. He gave us food for thought and much laughter. We think he saved the best till last. (Long member couple)

I'm delighted to share the effect John had on this stubborn old man! The Holy Spirit gifted John with a dynamic personality and special speaking talent to deliver his message. At times he was self-deprecating and I had a hard time controlling my admiration and approval for his message. John brought "Good News" to St. Julie Billiart! (Parish elder)

I was impressed that a lay person gives his life to do this. We should be grateful. Many are used to Father and Sister doing this! Now, we know lay persons are called as well. Strongest statement: Even if I was the only person in the world to ever mess up... Jesus would still come to save me and go through all of the suffering! Just for me! (Parish member)

John's point on a "call to action." It also touched me when he said, "We are a peaceful people but anger gets in the way." John gave me many points to remember. "There is no life in worry...so go to sleep... Lord, You deal with it." (Life member)

I came because we were told we could bring our Bibles. I have always wished for more Bible orientation and this is happening (e.g. Fr. Mike's extra scripture ideas on Sunday. I was very impressed. The two hours went all too quickly! One thing I took with me is that "God is God and I am not! (An interested parish member)

Mr. Schweisthal's wonderful animated style kept my attention while his approach to Christian life and the Gospel spoke to my soul. Stop worrying and trust in God's mercy. My twelve year old daughter took notes! Thanks so much for bringing John to conduct our parish mission. There was a message for all ages. (Mother of a large family)

In a nutshell, I thought the Mission was great! I was surprised at how easy it was for me to listen to John. The Monday evening talk impacted me deeply, and I hope that I will make some permanent changes in my life because of what he said to us. (30's Mom)

I arrived in my "comfort zone" and became "challenged" in short order. I listened, laughed, thought, and learned. Each night brought something new! I'm glad I took a chance! (Excited involved parish member)

We found ourselves enjoying the time together (minus kids) learning about our faith. The atmosphere had moments of humor with laughter, and we found ourselves with our defenses down.. letting the message come through. We look forward to more parish missions in the future.
